HISTORY OF OSHA ACTIONS AND LIST OF ON-THE-JOB INJURIES

Prior to award of the Contract, the apparent successful Bidder will be required to file with the City the following:

1. A history of all OSHA actions, advisories, etc., the Contractor has received on all jobs worked in any capacity, prime or subcontractor. The history shall be for the two-year period preceding the bid date of this Project.
2. A list of all on-the-job injuries, accidents, and fatalities suffered by any present or former employees of the Contractor during the same two-year period.
3. If less than the two-year period, give the date the Contractor started doing business.

This information must be submitted to the City within the time period stated in Document 00455 - Notice of Intent to Award. An officer of the company must certify in a notarized statement that the information submitted is true and correct.
